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### CONTROLS

<b>Elimination</b>	Look for housekeeping issues and clean them up. Maintaining the work as opposed to getting behind makes all the difference.
<b>Substitution</b>	
<b>Engineering</b>	Waste Material and debris shall be moved to a disposal area as often as is necessary to prevent a hazard.
<b>Administrative</b>	
<b>PPE</b>	High Visibility Clothing, Hard Hat & Safety Boots at a minimum must be worn at all times.
